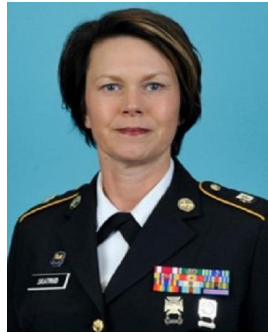

Master Sergeant Amanda Skatrud joined active duty in March of 1995. She completed Basic and Advanced Individual Training as a Paralegal Specialist at Fort Jackson, South Carolina.

Her first duty assignment was the DISCOM Legal Center, 4th ID; from there, she left active duty and joined the U.S. Army Reserves. She served with the 214th Legal Operations Detachment, Fort Snelling, Minnesota.

2004 she joined the Active Guard and Reserve as a USAR Recruiter. Her tour was completed in 2007, and she separated from the USAR. In 2010, she rejoined the USAR, reclassified to an Army Reserve Career Counselor, and served in that position until 2015.
